This form is to help you plan and choose courses for the upcoming school year.

## CHOOSING COURSES

Please follow the instructions in the right hand column and check off the courses you wish to take under the Student Choice column.

The courses passed in Grade 11 determine the Grade 12 courses that can be completed and, therefore, determines the post-secondary programs/careers to which students may pursue. (EG: biology 20 to biology 30 to nursing program or paramedic training).

Information about graduation or post-secondary requirements, can be researched through students' myBlueprint accounts and on the Oilfields' Student Services website. Grade 12 students are expected to meet with Ms. Isberg.

Choose courses carefully because the timetable is created based on student choices. Once the schedule has been built, specific changes may be difficult to make, depending on where courses are offered in each semester. Selection of a course does not ensure it will fit it into a student's schedule, although every attempt will be made to accommodate student choices.

- Grade 11 courses are pre-requisites for grade 12 courses.
- CALM/CTR and Physical Education 10 are mandatory for graduation. Students who did not take or pass either of these must register in the course(s).
- Select at least 4 option classes and numbered them (#1 being the top choice) to ensure timetable change flexibility. We will do our best to accommodate the top choices.
- Spares are offered in grade 12 only.
- Students are expected to graduate with 110 or more credits.

If students want to choose a class that they were NOT recommended for, and they passed the pre-requisite course, then students and parents must meet with our career/academic advisor or administrator to ensure an understanding of what that choice means (academic rigor, post-secondary choices and so on.)



Any student may apply to the **QUEST PROGRAM**, a multi-grade community of learners that engage in cross curricular inquiry through environmental and outdoor education.

If students plan on taking a course during **SUMMER SCHOOL**, they are still required to sign up for courses they may be taking in the summer, for the fall registration. Timetables can be changed once students show a course has been passed in summer school.
